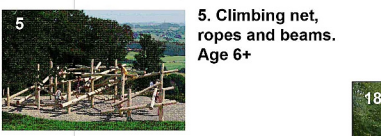

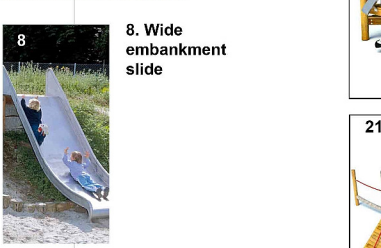

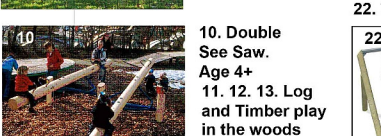

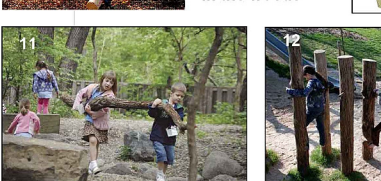

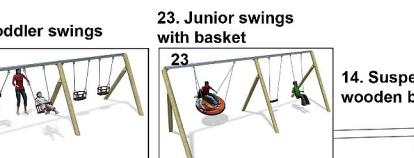

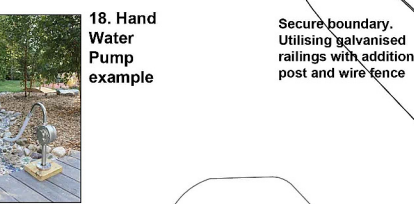

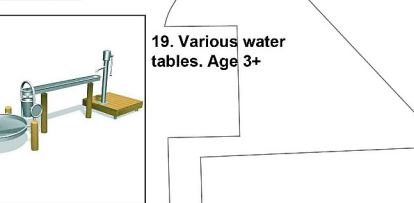

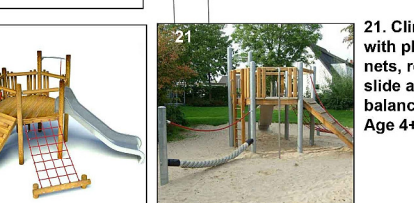

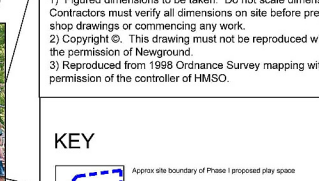

- Approx site boundary of Phase 1 proposed play space
 - Existing trees and canopy
 - Existing Blue Cedar Trees
 - Proposed trees
 - Moss grass
 - With areas left longer to encourage natural play and exploration
 - Longer grasses and wildflowers
 - Cropped hedgehog planting
 - Informal native wildlife hedgerows, shrubs and perennials
 - Tarmac footpaths with edge restraints, 1.8m wide
 - Sections of boardwalk or low bridges over furrows. Non-slip timber or recycled grip mats.
 - Play equipment and bases
 - For safety, ensure equipment for each item specified. (Minimum timber suitable for natural play is preferred)
 - Play Surfacing - Play Sand
 - Play Surfacing - Play Grit
 - Play Surfacing - Play Woodchip
 - Play Surfacing - Rubber matting / Natural coloured well pour
 - Cobbles and gravel - play value and toolways
 - Large natural boulders 800 - 1000mm to retain slopes, define edges and create informal sitting perches
 - Low stone walls approx 450 - 600mm high x 300mm wide to define boundaries and avoid access. Other posts as part of Welly Walk are low stepping logs
 - Timber and/or granite to retain slopes, define edges and create informal play tables, tunnels and seats
 - Timber posts approx 100mm diam x 900 - 1100mm high. To define boundaries and avoid access. Other posts as part of Welly Walk are low stepping logs
 - Benches and seats with backs located around the site. Areas of stone seats laid underneath - removed from other functions in the park
 - Picnic tables
 - Existing raised planters moved from old play space to east and re-located by existing path between sections of railings, foot and rail fence
 - Existing low top railings moved from old play space to road / path frontage. Integrate with hedgerows. Including access gates. Gates to be self closing and in contrasting colour.
 - Proposed additional fence to secure play space from wandering dogs. Timber post and rail with additional laser netting.
 - Existing levels and contours
 - Existing lower tunnels
 - Location of sections of boardwalk with opportunities for tunnels underneath
 - Proposed levels and contours at 0.5m intervals

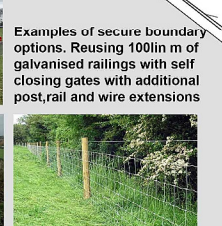

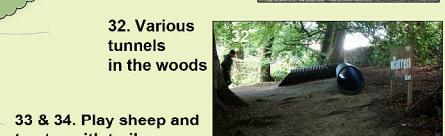

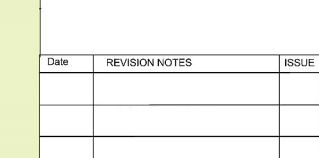
